Rally Argentina, as the championship continues into 1994, stands as one of the most spectacular and demanding gravel rallies on the World Rally Championship calendar. Based around the mountain resort of Villa Carlos Paz in the Córdoba region, the rally winds through dramatic landscapes of rocky hills, river crossings, and narrow mountain tracks.

The stages combine rough gravel with patches of bedrock, deep ruts, and water splashes that test both car durability and driver concentration. Elevation changes are constant, and the roads can shift from flowing high-speed sections to tight, technical climbs in an instant.

Huge crowds line the hillsides, creating an electric atmosphere, particularly on the legendary El Condor stage high in the mountains where fog, wind, and exposure make the challenge even greater.

Between 1987 and 1993, Rally Argentina has proven itself to be a rally where bravery, car control, and resilience are rewarded. As the 1994 season unfolds, it remains a rally that demands both precision and toughness from crews determined to conquer South America's most famous stages.
