Rallye Monte Carlo remains the ultimate test of nerve, precision, and adaptability as the Sim Rally Masters roars into the new year - it's the rally that everybody absolutely wants to win.

Between 1987 and 1993, the rally delivered a blend of glamour and chaos - twisting through the French Alps with a mix of dry tarmac, snow, and black ice that often changes corner to corner, let alone stage to stage.

Tyre choice continues to be a gamble; crews are often forced to compromise with mixed compounds, knowing one stage could be bone dry and the next a frozen gauntlet. Night stages through mountain passes like the Col de Turini still provide the defining moments of the rally - headlights piercing the darkness, engines echoing through icy valleys, and fortunes changing with the slip of a tyre.

Over the past seven years, the Monte has been shaped by both precision specialists and snow-savvy drivers who thrive in unpredictability.

As a new season begins, the legend of Monte Carlo is more alive than ever - the place where reputations are built or broken, one treacherous corner at a time.
