The Sanremo Rally, as the World Rally Championship enters the 1994 season, remains one of rallying's great asphalt classics - particularly on the twisting mountain roads high above the Mediterranean coast near Sanremo.

These tarmac stages are among the most technical and demanding in the championship, carving through steep Ligurian mountain passes with endless hairpins, narrow cliffside sections, and rapid changes in elevation.

Precision is everything; drivers must thread their cars between stone walls and barriers with scarcely any room for error, often attacking in darkness as the rally's famous night stages unfold under the glow of auxiliary lamps.

Grip levels can vary dramatically depending on weather, fallen leaves, or damp patches hidden beneath the trees, making tyre choice and confidence absolutely critical.

Between 1987 and 1993, Sanremo's asphalt mountains have rewarded specialists capable of combining aggression with finesse, where maintaining rhythm through the relentless sequence of corners is the key to victory.

As the 1994 season begins, the rally remains one of the purest tests of tarmac rally driving in the world.
